The Boise Angel Fund is a sub-group of the Alliance with dedicated capital for investing in high potential Idaho companies. The Fund leads all deals considered by the Boise Angel Alliance and invests upon a vote of the members of the Fund. Members of the Alliance may invest side-by-side with the Fund under the same terms.

The Boise Angel Fund is a member of the RAIN Fund Network. The RAIN Fund Network is a multi-state network of 23 RAIN Funds that work with angel investors interested in supporting growing companies. The Boise Angel Alliance is also a charter member of the Angel Capital Association (ACA) and a member of the NW Chapter of the Angel Capital Association.
